9. THE ONE AND THE MANY: Studies on God, Man the Church, and the World Today John D. Zizioulas, Metropolitan of Pergamon


This volume offers a collection of Zizioulas articles which have appeared mostly in English, and which present his Trinianatarian doctrine of God, as well as his theological account of the


10. SAILORS OF THE SKY A conversation with Fr. Stamatis Skliris and Fr. Marko Rupnik on contemporary Christian art


20. NOTES ON ECUMENISM St. Abba Justin




23. HOLY EMPEROR CONSTANTINE AND THE EDICT OF MILAN Bishop Athanasius Yevtich

drous synthesis gifted to us by the biblical and classical Greek understanding of Truth.


